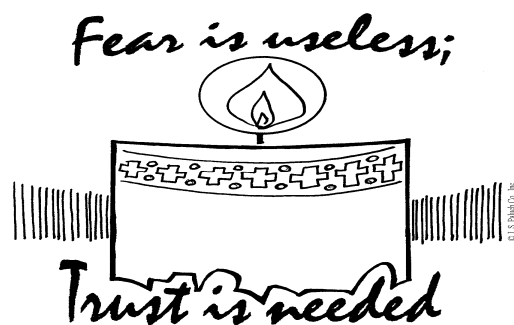

Please note 3 BIG changes to our Rel. Ed. program

1. **Our Sunday morning Religious Education session for 2009-2010, will be open to students in Grade K -6 only.** Due to the number of students wishing to participate in our Sunday morning Rel. Ed. Program, all Grade. 7& 8 students will meet on Monday evenings, every other week, 6:30-8 p.m. As usual, 2009-2010 Sunday morning Rel. Ed. classes will be filled on a first come, first serve basis.
2. **Sunday sessions will be limited** to 1 Kindergarten session and two sessions each Grades 1-6.
3. **During the week, two sessions each for Grades 1-6 will be offered on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays.** The 2009-2010 registration forms offers 1st, 2nd and 3rd choices for weekday classes (Gr. 1-6). These sessions will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. The idea is to make our program more “helpful” to busy parents by, hopefully, having elementary grade siblings attend Rel. Ed. classes on the same day. Perhaps, with the time saved, it may allow more parents the opportunity to teach our faith...
