Sharing your experiences of faith

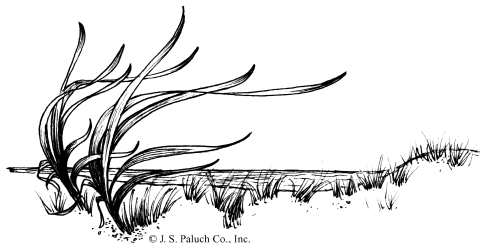
Recognizing the action of God in your daily life

## **Religious Education & Youth Ministry**

**2009-2010 registration forms** are available online, in the lower church (across from the kitchen) and in the parish office. 2009 First Communion & Confirmation are also there. **Our Sunday morning Religious Education session for 2009-2010, will be open to students in Grade K-6 only.** Due to the number of students wishing to participate in our Sunday morning Rel. Ed. Program, **all** Grade. 7& 8 students will meet on Monday evenings, every other week, 6:30-8 p.m.

**2009-2010** Sunday morning Rel Ed. classes and weekday Gr. 1-6 classes will be filled on a first come, first serve basis.

**Students entering Grades 2 & 10** as well as students new to our program, will not be assigned to classes unless a copy of his/her baptism certificate accompanies the complete 2009-2010 Rel. Ed. registration form if not baptized here at St. Margaret Mary Parish.

**Catechist manuals** should be dropped off in the lower church as soon as possible. We reuse these books because they are so costly. Thanks for everyone's cooperation.

**High School Harbor Cruise**, sponsored by The Archdiocese of Boston, sets sail July 27 (8-11 p.m.) and costs \$30. We'll leave St. Margaret Mary Parish at 6 p.m. and return around 12 midnight. The ship sets sail from Commonwealth Pier, Boston. Registration forms are available in the lower church (across from the kitchen) and in the parish office.

**Project Hope & Compassion:** Non-refundable \$100 deposit for all participants is overdue. Checks should be made payable to Saint Margaret Mary Parish; please note: Project Hope & Compassion.

**We still need an adult male** (CORI & at least 25 yrs. old). Of course our arms are open to as many adults as wish to attend. Adults will be required to submit a CORI form and attend a "Protecting God's Children" Workshop. Adults need not have a construction or building background. Our primary mission is to give hope to the survivors of Hurricane Katrina and to open our teen's eyes to the needs of others. Project Hope & Compassion is a week of prayer, service and community building. On this weeklong service trip, adults are asked to be mentors and support for our teens and each other.

**Other Important dates:** Sunday, August 2 (crack of dawn we leave) through Saturday, August 8 (late afternoon/early evening we return). On Saturday, August 1, participants and their families will attend the 4:30 p.m. Mass where Fr. Chris will bless us and send us forth. Participants will need to attend a 3:30 meeting August 1. There will also be mandatory meetings scheduled between now and the date we leave.
