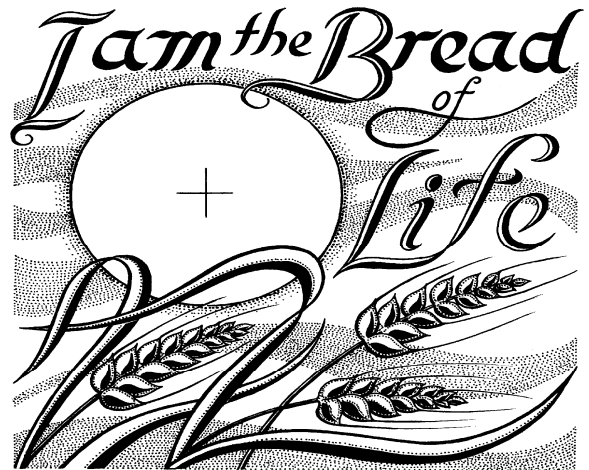

Ed. Program, **all** Grade 7 & 8 students will meet on Monday evenings, every other week, 6:30-8 p.m.
