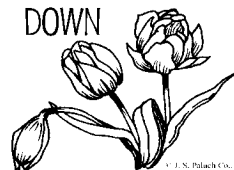
Concert Series

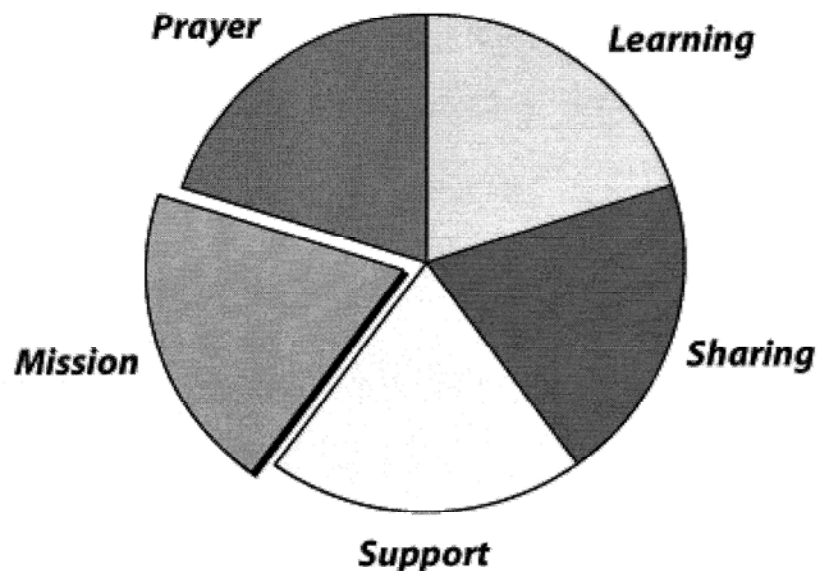
