1. All 2008-09 service logs **were due** June 1. Completing service hours and handing in a service log are requirements of our Religious Ed. & Confirmation Prep. Programs.
2. Students entering our Religious Education program must provide a copy of his/her baptism certificate.

Program and those not enrolled in our program last year (excluding Kindergarten and first grade students) must provide a letter from the pastor and/or DRE at the parish where you attended Religious Education stating that you did attend Religious Education classes. If you "took a year off" you must make up/complete the year missed.

4. Students wishing to enroll in our First Communion Program 2010 (Grade Two) must have completed at least one year of Religious Education.

5. Students in Gr. 7-10 have a "no absence" policy. Students must make up all missed sessions/classes.
